Action Plan for the Virtual Dual Immersion Meeting

Session 1 Overview of the Dual Immersion Program

Objective: Present to the audience the overview of the Dual Immersion Program: history of the program, School's and student's participation, current activities. Results of the survey.

Strategy: Presentation by the Dual Immersion Coordination.

Session 2 University Presentations

Objective: Know the trajectory of each participating university in the Dual Immersion program.

Strategy: Each participant university should make a ten-minute presentation outlining the following (in bullet point format):

- 1. Context:
 - a. Time of participation in the Program
 - b. Number of students and faculty involved
 - c. VDI model used (specify the most frequent)
- 2. Lessons learned
- 3. Best practices
- 4. Mayor challenges
- 5. Suggestions & additional resources needed

Session 3 Overview of AUSJAL-AJCU VDI Program Proposal/Group discussion on the topics: 1. Program Objectives 2. Program Model and 3. Pedagogy

Objective: Overview of AUSJAL-AJCU VDI Program proposal and discuss the following topics:

Topic #1: Program Objectives: Establish the program's vision, mission and objectives for the future. Objectives for the program, students and curriculum.

Topic #2: Program Model: Review the actual process and the model program functioning and responding what we do need to improve the program? Committee of the Dual Immersion Program.

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Topic #3: Pedagogy:

- Which is our philosophy?
- In terms of learning: What we are looking for?
- What are the student outcomes from the Virtual Dual Immersion sessions?
- What are the pedagogical activity materials that need to be developed for faculty and students involved in the program?
- What are the best practices currently in place that can be shared with faculty?
- What are the best/recommend assessments?
- What other pedagogical considerations should we be aware of as we move forward with the program?

Strategy: roundtables for group discussion of the different topics at the VDI AUSJAL-AJCU proposal. Each group should appoint a rapporteur to present their reflections and suggestions.

Session 4 Group discussion on topics: 4. Needs of the Program, 5.VDI Community of Practice, 6. Financial Model.

Objective: Analyze and discuss the following topics:

Topic #4: Needs of the program: technological Platform, web Site/LMS, Matching APP, Assessment tool. They will be provided as working material, with the document that describes the characteristics and function of the platform. Training: Do we have to create a training/introduction course for new institutions/teachers? Support: What kind of support the program needs?

Topic #5: VDI Community, they will be asked to discuss about: Developing the community of practice across the Americas. What is our vision?

Topic #6: Financial Model: For discussion on the financing needs of the program they will be provided as working material, with the draft financial/model proposal. Each group should appoint a rapporteur to present their reflections and suggestions.

Strategy: Roundtables for group discussion of the topics 4,5&6.

Session 5 Action Plan & Further needs.

Objective: Define a plan of action for the Dual Immersion Program based on the resulting discussions in sessions 3 and 4.

Strategy: the coordination of the program will present a wrap up of the conclusions/reflections resulting from the working sessions 3 & 4 in relation to the all topics discussed. With the contribution of the attendants we are going to develop an action plan with its timetable and actors.
